

# The British Record Society

## Introduction

The British Record Society (<http://www.britishrecordsociety.org/index.htm>) was founded in 1889 to compile, edit and publish indexes, calendars and transcripts of historical records, with a special interest in indexing wills and probate records to help the local historian and genealogist. As a result of their quiet industry, researchers can access material which would otherwise have been buried beyond retrieval in the archives of prerogative and other courts.

Most of the Epsom and Ewell material is testamentary, and to help with analysis I have separated entries from these volumes under two headings – wills made by people living in Epsom, Ewell and Cuddington at the time of their death, and wills which simply mention the area, either because the deceased owned property here, or because they were staying here at the time of their death. As the records approach the Spa period of the 1650s onwards, there is an increasing number of London merchants with town-houses in Epsom, who appear sometimes as residents of one place, and sometimes of the other.

Non-testamentary indexes include *The Act Books of the Archbishops of Canterbury*, for appointment of clergy, and *Cases in the Records of the Court of Arches*, which with its records of brawling in church and obstinately non-baptised babies gives a touch of human interest to the lists of names.

Researchers using the *Index of Wills Proved in the Prerogative Court of Canterbury* should note that the old will registers, which were named after the first person to feature in the volume, have now been superseded by TNA call numbers: thus the will of John Arnolde, which features below as 6 Logge, is now PROB 11/7. The modern references can be checked at <http://www.nationalarchives.gov.uk/documentsonline/willsdeathduties.asp>. The BRS index uses Old Style for its dates, whereas the National Archives use New Style, so that the years given in the two systems may not match up for people dying January–March. The later BRS *Union Index of Surrey Probate Records* uses New Style.
