

Monuments in the old churchyard of St. Mary's Ewell

This is a transcript of the notes made by the anonymous lady c.1949; it has not been checked against the monuments themselves. The numbers which she gave to graves have been altered to those used in the plan and index by Maurice Exwood. Punctuation has been added to her descriptive notes, where the identification such as 'Head and foot stone' have been standardised and some alterations have been made to clarify the descriptions of monuments. Otherwise the text is as it appears in her transcript, except that superscript letters at the end of words have been treated as abbreviations – <Jan^y> becomes <Jany.>, although in dates such as <1st> the superscription has been retained; <y^e> is transcribed throughout as <ye>. An ellipsis [...] has been used where she left blank spaces to indicate illegible text, as also in some cases where omissions show that there must have been text which is missing. Where she supplied missing text, as in <[who] died>, it appears in Roman in square brackets. For some reason, the words <wife of> are frequently transcribed in brackets, and these have been transcribed as square brackets although the convention may simply refer to the practice of placing one word above the other in legible text. However, no ellipsis has been added to transcripts such as <the 69 year of his age> where it is likely but not certain that a superscript <th> has been omitted. The ampersand has been transcribed throughout as <&> not <and> although it is not clear whether it appears thus on the monuments or is her own abbreviation. Her use of capital letters has also been retained as far as they could be distinguished, although again the relationship to the original lettering is not obvious. The use of double quotes <"> has also been retained although it is not certain that these appeared on the monuments rather than being her own introduction. No attempt has been made to follow her occasional transcription of long s or variant forms of 1. The marginalia which she added as comments on inscriptions (mostly, perhaps always, to incorporate information from her reading of the parish registers) appear in italic in square brackets; however, I have omitted mention of the ticks which she placed against dates, which seem to record that she had checked them against the parish registers and found that they were right. Where I have needed to confirm that a reading is as it appears in her notes, or to suggest that she may have misread the original, or to explain what her notes mean, I have also used square brackets but identified as JH.
